Membership Categories

ACTIVE – Registered pharmacists, in good professional standing, who support the goals and objectives of the society. Active members who are licensed in Florida are entitled to vote and to hold elected office.

JOINT – Active Membership for Registered pharmacists who are husband and wife receive a joint dues rate.

***NEW PRACTITIONER** – Active membership for newly graduated pharmacists (Must join within 6 months of graduation. Membership lasts until current membership cycle ends, January 1st or July 1st).

RESIDENT / FELLOW – Active Membership for registered pharmacists in a pharmacy residency or fellowship program.

ASSOCIATE – Members who by their work in the health services, the teaching of prospective health-system pharmacists or otherwise are contributing to health-system pharmacy, shall make themselves eligible for membership. Associate members are not eligible to vote or to hold elected office.

RETIRED – Pharmacists who no longer hold an active license and have retired are eligible. Pharmacists engaged in part-time work are not eligible for retired pharmacist membership. Retired members do not receive CE at Regional Society CE meetings.

TECHNICIAN – May be certified or non-certified.

STUDENT – Any unlicensed graduate or undergraduate in good academic standing. Students must be enrolled in an accredited school of pharmacy in the US. Students do not receive CE. (Licensed pharmacists enrolled in a post-baccalaureate doctor of pharmacy program or other graduate degree program are not eligible for student membership.)

NOTE: Membership years begin in January and July. Your membership will be processed to the nearest cycle.
